SUBJECT: Re-Scheduling or Postponing Games Due To Snow and/or Weather

Owing to the general scarcity of ice times within Associations as well as the difficulty involved in re-scheduling, League and Playoff games will only be postponed due inclement weather under the condition that a travel advisory has been issued by Environment Canada, the RCMP (or local police force), and/or the local municipality where the game is to be hosted.

Teams may not arbitrarily decide to postpone or re-schedule games due to weather. Teams **must** consult with and receive the permission of their League Manager before a game may be postponed due to weather. Additionally, teams may not request the postponement of a game due to weather more than 12 hours prior to the scheduled start time.

Teams are encouraged to actively monitor weather forecasts and, in the event of potentially disruptive weather (i.e.: snow), should ensure that they are proactive in communicating with the opposing team and their League Manager. Home teams are requested to monitor local conditions, including any advisories from their municipality, and to provide updates to their League Manager and the opposing team.

The default expectation is that games will be played as scheduled. Teams are reminded that games will go ahead even if a team has a reduced roster (to a minimum of 6 players).

Should a team be unable to reach their League Manager, they should contact their Association's President or their Division Coordinator.
